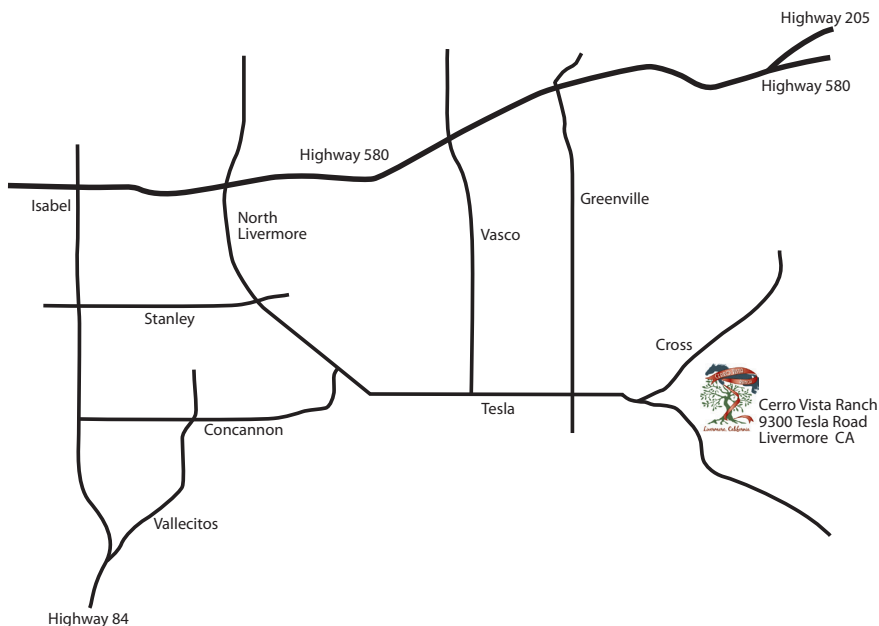

Cerro Vista Ranch and Stables

If towing a horse trailer, take Highway 580 and Exit at Vasco Road. Head South to Tesla Road and turn left. Continue through the stop sign at Greenville Road. Turn left on Cross Road and turn right onto the first gravel road on your right (follow signs).

If you are coming by car, we ask that you stay on Tesla Road and continue on past Cross Road and turn left at the first driveway (9300 Tesla Road, featuring a rearing horse).

Rules and Show Information

Riders entering on day of show will pay a \$20 post entry fee.

Every person riding on show grounds must sign or have a parent or guardian sign a release form.

The age of the exhibitor on January 1, 2017 shall be maintained throughout the competition calendar year.

A minimum of three entries will constitute a class.

Points are awarded as follows: First – 10 points, Second – 6 points, Third – 4 points, Fourth – 2 points, Fifth – 1 point.

Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes.

Trotting and simple changes will not be penalized in poles, crossrails, and 18" hunters.

Leadline riders may not cross enter into any other divisions on the same show date.

Hunter Over Poles riders may not cross enter into any jumping class over 2' on the same show date.

Hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness. Manners shall be emphasized and extreme speed penalized.

Jumpers will be timed using Argentine timing in Divisions 1 and 2. Table II.2(b) will be used for Divisions 3 and 4.

All riders, whether showing or not, shall wear hard hats and boots. Approved protective headgear must be worn when riding anywhere on the grounds. Junior riders must have chinstraps fastened whenever mounted.

Neatness is a must. Huntcoats are optional. Breeches and boots are required.

Any animal abuse will not be tolerated and may result in ejection from the show.

No dogs allowed on property at any time.

Food is available on premises.

Warm-up arenas/areas are available.

Show will be held rain or shine.

All disputes involving placing are to be resolved by the horseshow management. Approaching the judge will not be tolerated.
